

Creating safe transit systems

Regular data collection and audits on riders' safety.

Clear and publicly available reporting policies.

Training and bystander education for transit operators and the public.

Safe and gender-responsive transit infrastructure, including pedestrian-friendly routes, good lighting, visible staff, emergency buttons and security cameras.

Gender-responsive transit services, including request-stop programs that allow riders to get off transit at locations closer to their destination and more frequent services that align to women's travel patterns.
