

THE IMPACT OF FINANCIAL ABUSE

Financial abuse is often unseen. However, survivors say that its impact on their lives can be extreme.

These insights are based on a WomanACT survey (103) and interviews (10) with women and gender-diverse people in Ontario with lived experience of intimate partner violence.

Of respondents said their partner got angry about how they spent their money.



44%

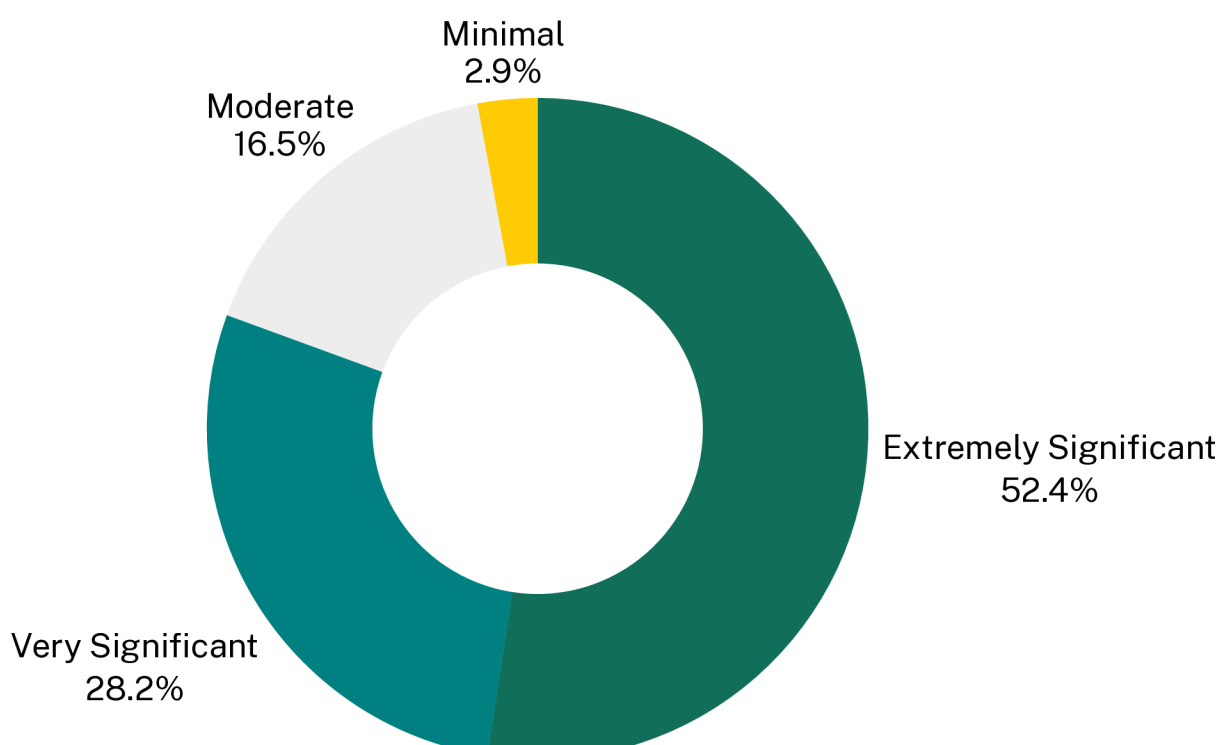
Of respondents had to ask their partner if they wanted access to money.
